

VISVESVARAYA INDUSTRIAL AND TECHNOLOGICAL MUSEUM, BANGALORE

Biotechnology Gallery at the museum was inaugurated on 15th February 2021 by Prof. G Padmanaban, Former Director, Indian Institute of Science of Science, Bengaluru in the presence of Prof. T G Sitharam, Director, IIT Guwahati & Chairman, Executive Committee, VITM.

The Exhibition "Superbugs- The End of Antibiotics" was inaugurated on 23rd November 2020 at the museum virtually through videoconferencing mode by Dr. VivekJawali, Chairman-Cardiovascular Sciences & Medical Advisory Council, Member-Medical Council of India (Academic Council), Bangalore in the presence of Prof. T G Sitharam, Director, IIT Guwahati & Chairman, Executive Committee, VITM, Ms. Helen Jones, Director, Global Engagement & Strategy, Science Museum Group London and several dignitaries. The exhibition was on display up to 3rd January 2021. During the period as part of the exhibition several Webinars, Online multimedia Visual quiz, Street play on 'Antibiotics Resistance & Superbugs, Open house quiz, Treasure hunt contests, Drawing contests, Comic contests and hands on activity on 'Superbugs' were organised.

A Panel Exhibition on 'Nobel Prizes – 2020' developed in house at VITM was opened at the museum on 10th December 2020. The exhibition on 'The Father of the Nation' a Digital Tribute was inaugurated at the Museum on 8th January 2021 by Shri K. G. Raghavan, Chairman, Bharatiya VidyaBhavan, Bangalore.

Due to Covid – 19 pandemic, the Galleries of Museum and its Satellite Units were closed from 15th March 2020 and was reopened for public on 10th November 2020 by following Standard operating procedures as per Govt. of India and Government of Karnataka Directives. Arrangements were made for contactless hand washing station with liquid soap at the entry of the museum, temperature scanning near the entry, online ticket booking-digital payment for entry tickets purchase, contactless hand sanitising, social distancing, contactless sensor based operation of exhibits and Online awareness programmes about Covid -19 were part of the SoP.

However the museum continued to reach its visitors by organising several programmes online. Programmes like Webinars and interactions, seminars for students and teachers, Quiz Contest, Elocution contest and many more. Online Creative ability courses 'Perform and Experience experiments in Chemistry' and 'Hand on experience in basic Electronics' were organised in the month of July and October 2020 respectively. Kits containing Apparatus, Chemicals, components and tools were provided to the participants as part of the programme. In addition, IEEE VITM App development on Android and Python course were also conducted through online mode.

Museum celebrated several commemorative events like National Technology Day, International Museum Day, World Environment Day, International Science Centre & Museum Day, National Mathematics Day, National Science Day, International day of Women and Girls in Science and International Women's Day by organising webinars and contests for students and general public.

REGIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE, TIRUPATI

Reddy, DEO, Chittoor inaugurated the New MSE bus. Folder on New MSE 'How Things Works' was also released by the dignitaries.

The Exhibition on 'a Digital Tribute to the Father of the Nation' was inaugurated on 18th December 2020 by Shri. Gopalakrishna Murthy Gandrakota, Executive Director, Academy of Gandhian Studies, Tirupati.

An Online CAC on Electronics & Arduino was organised at the centre for the students from 28th September to 9th October 2020. As part of the programme Kit & Components were provided to the registered participants. The Centre organised Vacation Creative Ability Course at the centre from 11th to 17th January 2021 for school students in Physics, Chemistry and Bioscience. Various curriculum based science activities were conducted during the CAC.

Series of Webinars on Nobel Prizes 2020 was held by organising talks by several eminent personalities on the topics of the Nobel prize 2020. Many webinars were conducted by the centre and invited eminent personalities across the country and abroad to deliver talk on various topics related to science. The webinars were live streamed in Facebook and YouTube channel of the centre.

Live Streaming of Partial Solar eclipse was organised on 21stJune 2020. Special Sky Observation Programme was held during Jupiter and Saturn Great Conjunction on 21st December 2020. The Centre collaborated with All Indian Radio, Tirupati, National Atmospheric Research Laboratory, B. M labs, Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Tirupati, Indian Science Congress Association, Tirupati Chapter in organizing Phone in Live Quiz, Moon Landing Week and Teacher Training Programme etc.

The Centre organised community programmes like International Women's Day and many online workshops such as Origami, Fun with toys and Coding for beginners and offline workshops in microscope making and Teacher Training Programme for Government Biology Teachers. The Centre continued to organise many programmes in commemoration of Birth anniversary of scientists and discoveries /inventions made.

REGIONAL SCIENCE CENTRE AND PLANETARIUM, CALICUT

The Centre has taken up fabrication of a new MSE exhibits on Mathematics and is in progress.

The centre maintained connection to its visitors during the pandemic period by organizing programmes through virtual channels online. A You Tube channel RSCP Calicut Virtual was created in 2020. A series of lectures, webinars titled FIRST Hand was conducted throughout the year. Eminent personalities, scientists joined in the online activities.

The centre and The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, Kozhikode Branch is jointly setting up a man-made urban forest at RSC Calicut premises, inspired by the MIYAWAKI model of afforestation. The project is taken up under the Corporate Social Responsibility scheme of ICAI, Kozhikode Branch.

Zero shadow day was observed on 18thApril 2020. Various experiments and demonstrations were performed during the period. The event was live webcast through Facebook and other social media.

Online summer hobby camps were conducted on 'Introduction to electricity, Colourful Chemistry, Electronic Circuit Design, Introduction to Computer programming, Introduction to Astronomy & Astrophysics and Introduction to Arduino & Sensors in the month of May & June and July 2020.

A five days online workshop on Artificial Intelligence & Robotics was held from 17th to 21st August 2020. Talks, Tutorials and Hands-on Demonstrations were the part of the workshop.

Online workshops on 'home automation using Arduino' & 'Robotics using Arduino' were organised by the Centre on 21st& 23rd February 2021 respectively for students.

In connection with the partial solar eclipse on 21st June 2020 the Centre organized various programmes from 17th June to 21stJune 2020. On the eve of 'Great Conjunction of Jupiter and Saturn' on 21st December 2020, the centre set up telescopes at Calicut beach for viewing the event from 6.30pm to 8.00 pm. About 3,600 students and general public gathered for viewing the planets through telescope. The event was live webcast through You tube channel. As part of this event a workshop on making Crosstaff was conducted on 18th December 2020 both offline and online.

The Centre celebrated its **24th ANNIVERSARY** on 30th January 2021 by organising various online programmes on 29th & 30th January 2021. Shri. K. Madan Gopal Director VITM inaugurated the programme on 29th January 2021. He delivered an online talk on "Building RSC & Planetarium, Calicut making a Social impact" followed by a talk by Mr. Martin Kraus Head of Business field Planetariums Carl Zeiss jena on 'Influencing factors for a perfect image'. An online panel discussion creating hybrid planetarium shows was held on 30th January 2021. Experts in the field of Planetarium lead the session.

The Centre continued to organise several Commemorative events like Moon landing Week. World Space Week. National Nutrition Month, Children's Day, National Science Day etc. with various online activities and competitions. The centre published two monographs on the Social Inclusion of the Transgender People and Solar Eclipse.




