




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VISVESVARAYA INDUSTRIAL AND TECHNOLOGICAL MUSEUM, BANGALORE

Visvesvaraya Industrial and Technological Museum (VITM), Bangalore (a unit of NCSM) is the Southern Zonal Head Quarters of NCSM. VITM was established in 1965. It has under its administrative control of satellite units RSC Tirupati (1993), RSC P Calicut (1997), DSC Gulbarga (1984) and DSC Tirupelveli (1987).

The year 2021-22 witnessed new growth in the activities of the museum like completion and handing over of gallery, Science Park and Innovation Hubs set up as catalytic support under SPoCS, setting up of new exhibitions and organising new programmes.

1. New Exhibition & Galleries and Science Park:

VITM provided Catalytic Support to other organisations/institutions by setting up of Science Centres.

 students and general people participated.






